

HEALTHCARE MBA PROGRAM MERIT SCHOLARSHIP

SCHOLARSHIP DETAILS:

This \$10,000 scholarship opportunity was designed to reward individuals who have shown exemplary academic and work achievements. The scholarship will be granted on a proportional basis as the student completes the program, and will be used to compensate value-added program charges. Applications are reviewed <u>after admission</u> into the program. While students can apply for multiple Healthcare MBA program scholarships, they may only receive <u>one award</u>. Healthcare MBA program scholarships may not be combined. Students receiving a merit scholarship are not eligible for partnership scholarships unless they forgo the former.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- ✓ Admission into Healthcare MBA program with paid deposit
- ✓ Must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.400 in upper division undergraduate coursework (UG60) (GPA is calculated by FIU's College of Business Admissions Office)
- ✓ Possess three (3) or more years of work experience in the healthcare field (internships may be considered)

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

Effective Fall 2020 for incoming students only. Applications received after deadline will not be accepted/prorated.

- ✓ Fall Semester Applicant Deadline July 15th
- ✓ Spring Semester Applicant Deadline December 1st
